THE DOMINICAN ROSARY CONFRATERNITY

The responsibilities are as follows:

1. Be a baptized Catholic.
2. Say the full 15 decades of the rosary at least once a week while meditating on them. This means just 5 decades a day, but must say the 15 mysteries (Joyful, Sorrowful and Glorious) over a one-week period. The minimum number of rosaries said is just three a week.
3. Possess a blessed rosary (for the indulgences). The normal blessing (*Benedictio coronarum sacratissimi Rosarii B.M.V.* – Rituale romanum Appendix no. 35) is correct for the Confraternity requirement. It can be given by any priest.
4. None of the rules oblige under pain of sin.
5. There is no required ceremony, simply turn in the membership form.



The graces you receive are too many to enumerate here, but some of them are as follows:

1. During your life and after your death, you share in all the prayers, Masses, penances and good works of the great Dominican family.
2. 100 **years** and 100 Quarantines (1 quarantine = 40 days), once a day, for **members** who devoutly carry a rosary about with them.
3. Over 30 popes have endowed the Confraternity with special indulgences, some are listed in Pope Leo XIII's Constitution *Diuturni temporis*, Sept. 5, 1898.
4. Naturally a meditated rosary benefits your soul, regardless of membership in the Confraternity. Nevertheless the greater power of the rosary is within the Confraternity as given to us by Holy Mother Church in all her indulgences.
